

Hyland Hills Men's Flag Football Rules

House Rules

1. **Zero tolerance** for anyone involved with verbal or physical abuse. This includes and is not limited to officials, field supervisors, players or spectators.
 - a. **Penalty Box:** Officials may have any player sit out for a two minute minor or a five minute major. No substitution is allowed during the penalty.
 - b. **Single Ejected Player:** must leave the premises entirely – go home. The player is suspended for the next game. Player is required to pay a \$50 fine to Hyland Hills before being allowed to participate again. If a player is ejected twice within a season that player will be banned from playing at Hyland Hills for 1 year minimum.
 - c. **Multiple Ejections':** two or more players from the same team. This is considered a team problem. Team automatically forfeits game. Players ejected must pay the \$50 fine and serve a one game suspension. The team must also pay a \$100 fine before participating the next week.
 - d. **Elastic Power:** Hyland Hills reserves the right to suspend or terminate any person or team from the league at any time. No refund will be given. The athletic supervisor may make decisions not specifically covered in the rules; all decisions are final.
2. **The Field Supervisor:** is only responsible for setting up the fields, recording scores, injury reports, ejection reports and answering general questions.
3. **Winning Team Manager:** is responsible for reporting the final score to the field supervisor after every game. Failure to do so may result in a loss.
4. **Scores & Standings:** will be available with the field supervisor on a weekly basis. You may also view the standings at www.hylandhills.org
5. **Forfeits** – If a team is a no show at a scheduled game, then that team will not be eligible for any league awards or be allowed to play in the post season tournament. Any team involved in two or more forfeits as the result of ejections or fighting will also not be eligible for league awards or tournament play.
6. **Weather Line #:** 303-650-7551. Please only have the manager call to pass the information on to the players.
7. **Rosters** must be turned in to the field supervisor by the 1st game. Rosters must have all players' legible name and signature to be considered a legal player. Players must be 18 years of age to participate. Players may only play for one team per league. Players may only play for one team in the tournament. (Roster protests must be made before play starts by notifying the officials and site supervisor. The player in question has 5 minutes to provide proof of ID or that player will be considered ineligible to participate in the game. **A team may protest a late arriving player. That protest must be made before that player plays 1 play in the game. NOTIFY THE OFFICIALS IMMEDIATELY.**)
- 7A. **50% Rule:** Participants are allowed to play on more than one team as long as the teams are in different leagues. Teams are not allowed to carry more than 50% of one team's roster to another team's roster.
8. Hyland Hills reserves the right to re-classify a team at any point in the season in order to maintain a fair balance of competition.
9. Teams can start & finish with a minimum of 6 players.

10. All players will be required to have their ID'S on them for the tournament. If there is a roster protest, the player in question has 5 MINUTES to produce their ID or they will be considered an ineligible player and will not be allowed to participate in the tournament. (The ID rule is being enforced at the team mangers request. There was concern about players jumping from team to team once their original teams lost.)

11. PLAYERS MAY ONLY PLAY FOR 1 TEAM IN EACH TOURNAMENT AND MUST BE ON YOUR ROSTER. (A player may play in the championship and consolation bracket if they are on those teams roster. If a player is on two rosters from different leagues and both are in the same tournament, that player must choose 1 team to play for and cannot switch teams if the team he chose to play for loses.)

Make sure that you and your team have read and understand the rules.
