CHALLENGER DIVISION OF LITTLE LEAGUE

The Challenger division of Little League is a program that allows children from ages 5-18 with any type of special need (mental or physical disability) to participate in a baseball program during the summer. Colorado District Two operates three Challenger Programs, one in the Perl Mack Little League (72nd and Zuni), one in the Northern Lights Little League (139th and York) and one in the North Boulder Little League (16th and Iris in Boulder).
